# Navigating the ODR-CAP



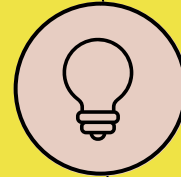
## Step 1

Apply as per the guidelines. The selection of the cohort will be notified by 11 September 2023



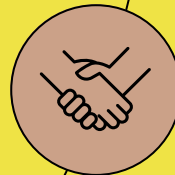
## Step 2

Upon selection, undergo the orientation process with the cohort



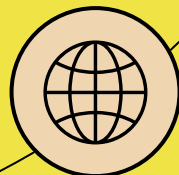
## Step 3

- On getting shortlisted, an interview shall be conducted.
